

The Lincoln Parish Police Jury met in special session on Thursday, January 8, 2015, at 5:30 p.m., at its regular meeting place in the Courthouse, Ruston, Louisiana. Present were: Theresa Wyatt, District One; Hazel D. Hunter, District Two; Bobby Bennett, District Three; Randy Roberson, District Four; David Hammons, District Five; Walter Pullen, District Six; Jody Backus, District Seven; Skip Russell, District Eight; Joe Henderson, District Nine; Nancy Wilson, District Ten; Sharyon Mayfield, District Eleven; District Twelve (seat open).

President Hazel Hunter called the meeting to order and Randy Roberson delivered the invocation.

Walter Pullen offered a motion, seconded by Randy Roberson, to approve the Agenda. The motion was voted upon and carried with the following votes:

The President asked for public comments on the agenda as approved. There were no public comments by anyone in attendance.

Theresa Wyatt offered a motion, seconded by Joe Henderson, to open the floor for nominations. The motion was voted upon and carried with the following votes:

Theresa Wyatt nominated Mr. Aaron James. Walter Pullen nominated Mrs. Heather Walker. There being no further nominations forthcoming, David Hammons offered a motion, seconded by Randy Roberson, to close nominations. The motion was voted upon and carried with the following votes:

President Hunter called for votes on the appointment for the District Twelve representative, by a show of hands. The results were as follows:

FOR: Hunter, Bennett, Roberson, Hammons, Pullen, Backus and Russell

Mr. Aaron James received four (4) votes. Mrs. Heather Walker received seven (7) votes.

President Hunter declared Heather Walker the duly appointed Juror of the Lincoln Parish Police Jury for District Twelve.

The meeting was adjourned by the President. As there was still an item under IV, Other Business to attend to, the President reconvened the meeting. Joe Henderson offered a motion,

seconded by Bobby Bennett, to adopt a resolution appointing Heather Walker as the Representative for District Twelve filling the unexpired term of Police Juror, District 12.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lincoln Parish Police Jury in legal and special session that Heather Walker, 1502 St. John, Ruston, LA 71270 hereby is appointed as Police Juror, District 12, Lincoln Parish, to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Ronny Walker, and fill the unexpired term of Police Juror, District 12.
